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Prescription Refill Policy

Prescription refill requests are important to you and they are important to us. We strive to keep our patients happy with our professional services. To help us give you the best care possible, please review all your medication needs prior to your visit with your psychiatrist. Be ready to let your psychiatrist know what medicines and at what doses you are currently taking, and how much medicine you have left. You and your psychiatrist will plan medication refills based on your needs so that you will have medicine to cover you until your next appointment.

Medication management requires regular follow-up visits, and your psychiatrist will let you know when you are expected back. You may want to set up this next appointment as you leave the office to better keep you up to date with your medicine.

If you are overdue for a visit and run out of prescription refills, your doctor may approve a refill to last until your scheduled appointment up until a maximum of a 2 week supply. This prescription refill is at the discretion of your doctor, so please try to avoid the necessity of this type of refill by keeping up to date with appointments.

At all times we require at least 48 business hours in which to complete your refill requests.

In the case of controlled substances, such as many medications for ADHD, a written prescription is necessary for each refill. You and your provider will set up a system that will enable you to pick up these paper prescriptions, but keep in mind that we need 5 business days to process these types of refill requests since your specific provider needs to be the one to authorize these refills.
